Job Title: Concrete Finisher

Job Summary:

Brayman Precast is seeking Concrete Finishers for full-time positions for our precast concrete manufacturing plant located in Saxonburg, PA. This position is part of our finishing crew which performs all phases of concrete production, placement and finishing. While the ideal candidates will have experience specific to placing and finishing concrete, Brayman Precast is willing to train the right candidate in the skills they need to be successful in this position.

Primary Duties/Responsibilities:

- Daily preparation/maintenance of equipment and hand tools.
- Operation of overhead cranes and pneumatic equipment to transport and place fresh concrete.
- Use of electric vibrators to consolidate concrete
- Uses a variety of tools, such as straight-edges, floats, rakes, shovels, trowels, and brooms to apply required finishes to fresh concrete
- Cleans surface, tools, and surrounding area thoroughly.
- Cover finished product with plastic or thermal blankets.
- Strict adherence is Brayman Precast's quality manual.

Secondary Duties/Responsibilities:

- Assisting other crews (carpenters, rebar, yard) as needed and as time permits.
- General housekeeping duties.
- Performs other related duties as assigned.

Required Skills/Abilities:

- Experience with batching, placing and finishing concrete is desirable but not required.
- Knowledge of and ability to use tools related to concrete is desirable.
- Ability to read and interpret blueprints is a plus.
- Overhead crane experience is a plus.
- Ability to work as part of a crew of 5-6 people is mandatory.
- Due to the nature of concrete production, reliable attendance is crucial. Excessive tardiness/absences cannot be tolerated.

Education and Experience:

- High school diploma or equivalent.

Work Environment:

- Works in concrete production plant facility and on construction sites indoors and outdoors.
- Environment can be dirty and noisy.
- Wears appropriate protective clothing and equipment including regular use of hard hat, safety glasses, gloves and steel toe boots.
- Other equipment may be required including ear protection, respirators and fall protection as necessary and as provided by the company.
- Typical schedule is 10:00am – 6:30pm, Monday – Friday. Overtime is possible but not guaranteed.

Physical Requirements:

- Lifting up to 50 LBS.
- Stands and walks continuously within the plant.
- Frequently stretches and reaches across formwork to place, consolidate and finish concrete.
- Squatting, crouching or kneeling may be required occasionally.
- Twisting the body or neck may be required occasionally.
- Bending is occasionally required to facilitate the lifting of items to add to the production process.
- Contact with skin irritants or water may occur during production processes such as when adding raw materials to make concrete.
- Employees frequently lift and carry raw materials.
- Repetitive hand and arm movements are required.
- The employee must be able to perform the physical demands of the job with or without reasonable accommodation.
